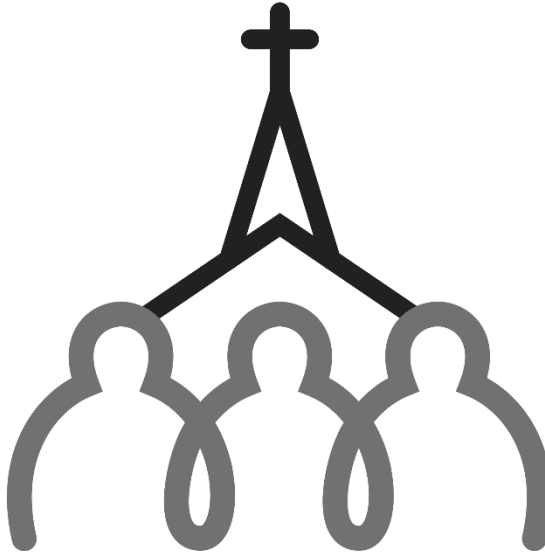
### **Scholarships**
