Volunteers Needed

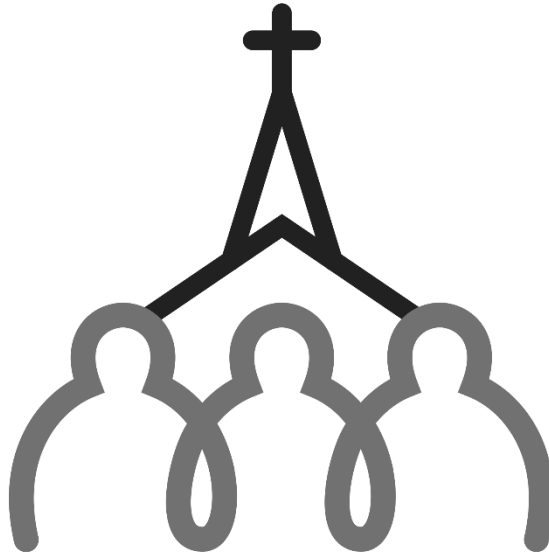
