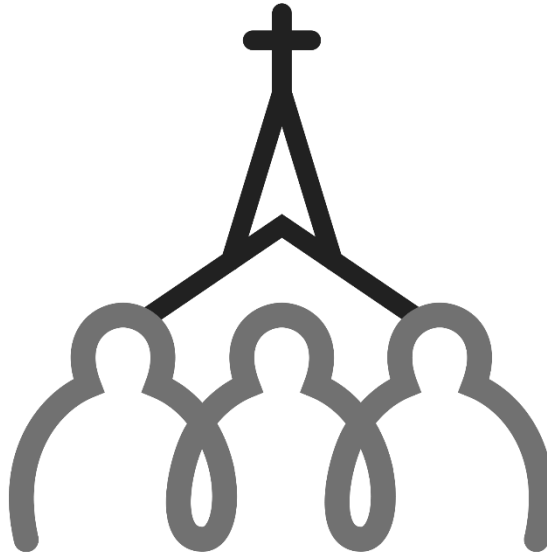
Welcome to Our Guests
