### GABC Great Family Campout!

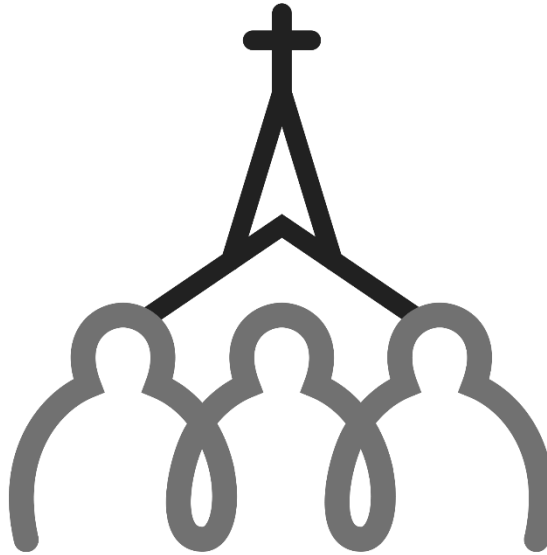
