WOMEN'S DAY SPEAKER

Kärin Williams, an actress, writer and speaker, will be the guest speaker at Glen Allen Baptist Church's Women's Day SERVICE today. Her valuable message is "**Freedom Is A Gift.**"

Kärin was a scholarship attendee at the American Academy of Dramatic Arts in New York City and received her B.I.S. (Dramatic Performance and Russian Studies) from George Mason University.

As an actress, Kärin wrote, directed and performed a one-woman show called "Images of Soviet Life" used by the Fairfax County School system to teach students about the truth about communism. She also performed the show in the Helen Hayes Theater, National Theater, in Washington, DC. "Images" grew from living in the Soviet Union from 1979 – 1981 while her husband served as a Naval Attaché in the American Embassy, Moscow. Most recently, she has used that inspiration to write and perform a talk called "Freedom is a Gift" and to author a children's book called "Spunky Comes to America."

She has been speaking over the past eleven years along the eastern seaboard for Christian Women's Connection, a global outreach of Stonecroft Ministries. While living in the Tampa Bay area, Kärin co-hosted daily television programs called "Together Again" and "Positive People" at CTN and co-hosted the morning drive radio show called "Paul and Kärin in the Morning" on AM 1040.

Kärin has been a Big Sister in St. Petersburg, a counselor at the Crisis Pregnancy center in Norman, Oklahoma, prayer chair for a women's ministry (W.O.V.E.N.) and is a commissioned Stephen Minister. She and her husband John have been married almost forty-eight years. Together they facilitate a small group for Needle's Eye Ministries every Wednesday. Karin and John live within minutes of their two children, their spouses and four grandchildren in Mechanicsville.
