Notes from the Past:



Today as we celebrate Scout Sunday, we look back at the history of the Boy Scouts at Glen Allen Baptist Church.

In 1937 Glen Allen was issued a charter for Boy Scout Troop 39 with Reverend Roy Carner as pastor and C. Howerton Parsons, Sr. being the first Scout Master. This troop under the sponsorship of the Church continued for 41 years of unbroken service to God and Country.

In 1949 the Scout lodge was built. The RF&P Railroad donated materials for the lodge including a boxcar that was taken apart for lumber and the front door was a door formerly used on a dining car belonging to the railroad. The Scout Lodge was built by Boy Scouts and leaders, for the Boy Scouts. A letter of dedication, dated February 11, 1951, dedicating the 'Youth Lodge' for the Youth of Glen Allen Baptist Church, hangs in the lodge today, and is signed by George H Moody, deacon chairman, and Elmer Stone West, Jr., pastor. In the 1960's the Scout Lodge was heated by a kerosene stove inside the front door. The stove took about 15 minutes to light and get going.

Boy Scout Troop 39, later became 639 in the Robert E. Lee Council, then 739. A new Boy Scout Troop was started in 1995, Troop 795, and is participating in Scout Sunday at Church today.

The pictures are of Boy Scout Troop 639. In one picture David Stone is the tall Scout standing by the door. Some of the other Scouts that can be seen include Craig Robertson, Jimmy Arnett, Rick Arnett, Albert Diesti, Steve Brown, Richard Johnson, Curtis Hanson, Doug Cone, Mel Ford, Frankie Beal, Jim Gocke, Karl Harris, Jr., Randy Pittman, Bruce Eckert, and Ronnie Oliver. The other picture is of Earl and son Bruce Eckert, and Forrest and Eddie Melton.
