Since 1969 the Virginia Baptist Disaster Response Team has partnered with volunteers to work through local churches to meet the needs of disaster survivors. Their mission is to mobilize volunteers to meet human needs after disasters. They were very busy in 2017.

Volunteers served across nine communities in five states and Puerto Rico. Following hurricanes, the volunteer teams served 44,398 meals in Florida, cleaned up 191 homes in Texas, and purified hundreds of gallons of water in Puerto Rico.
