Notes from the Past:

The person standing to the left in this close-up of some early members of GABC is Mordecai John "Mock" Gayle, born March 10, 1826. On March 9, 1848, at age 22, Mordecai Gayle married America Virginia Broaddus, when she was 15, and together they had 15 children.

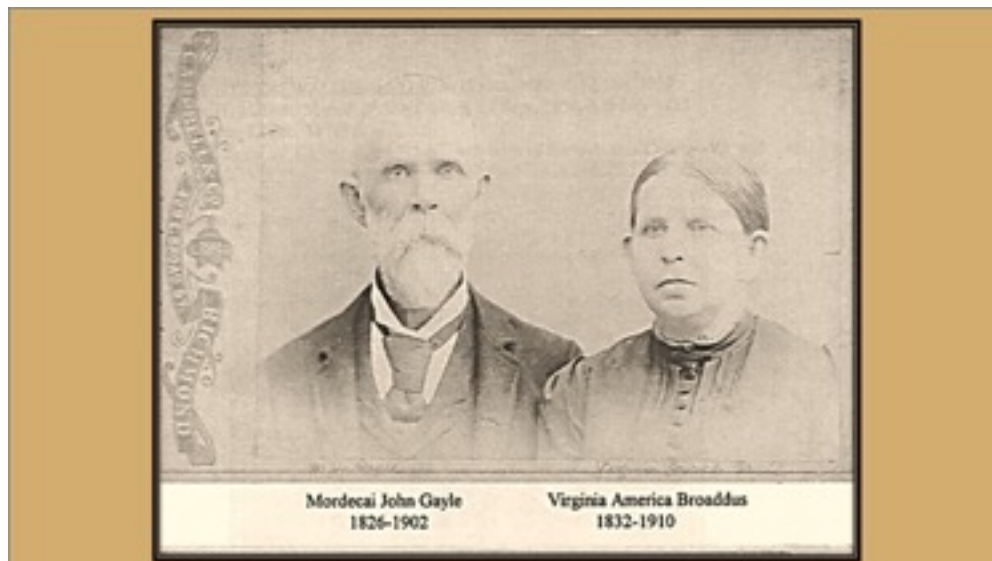
During the Civil War, Mordecai served as a Confederate soldier and member of Company F. "Mosby's Battalion" under Colonel John Singleton Mosby (1833-1916), the "Grey Ghost." Official title of his unit: Company F. 43rd Battalion Partisan Cavalry, Dept. of Northern Virginia, C.S.A. The story of these partisans has gone on to become legend- they were tough, daring and the bravest of the brave. Mordecai told his grandchildren that he "killed as many of them (Yankees) as they killed of me."

Mordecai and "Ginny" were founding members of Glen Allen Baptist Church in 1868.

According to descendants, Ginny was a tiny, lively, sweet and loving person and her grandchildren loved to have her come visit because she always had goodies, lemon and peppermint stick candy in her apron pocket.

Mordecai died on October 3, 1902 and Ginny on July 10, 1910 at the home of their son John B. Gayle at 2500 Floyd Avenue, in Richmond. They are buried in Riverview Cemetery, Richmond, Va.
