NOTES FROM THE PAST



The multi-part series which begins with today's bulletin is from an 8 page booklet, entitled "GLEN ALLEN MY COMMUNITY", which was in the possession of Big Boy Gasser. It is thought to possibly have been authored by Roland Harris around the 1970s or earlier. So begins Part 1:

**THE HISTORY OF MY COMMUNITY
GLEN ALLEN**

This part of Henrico was not known as "Glen Allen" until after the War Between the States, when it was named after the old homestead of Mrs. Benjamin Allen. It used to be called "Mountain Road Crossing". There was no (railroad) station, post-office, store, school or church, only a few dwellings and broad stretches of forests, pasture land, an occasional patch of Indian corn or tobacco. A river and tavern were named for this tribe. Even to this day arrows and old flint can be found. Near this tavern and river are "Deer Lick Spring". Here wild deer came to drink and lick the salt rocks.
