NOTES FROM THE PAST



Glen Allen My Community, Part 5:

Meadow Farm is now owned by Colonel Sheppard Crump. The original building is still standing, and probably built a few years after the grant was given to William Sheppard. Its immense rooms are

attractive. Situation and old style architecture give it unusual charm. During the Civil War it was occupied by Dr. Mosby Sheppard, grandfather of Colonel Crump. Members of the family remember the raid made by Custer, who was one of the generals in Sheridan's army, also a skirmish which took place on the farm in front of the house with the line of battle stretching for more than a mile. There was another raid in this vicinity, but the troops and date are not known.
