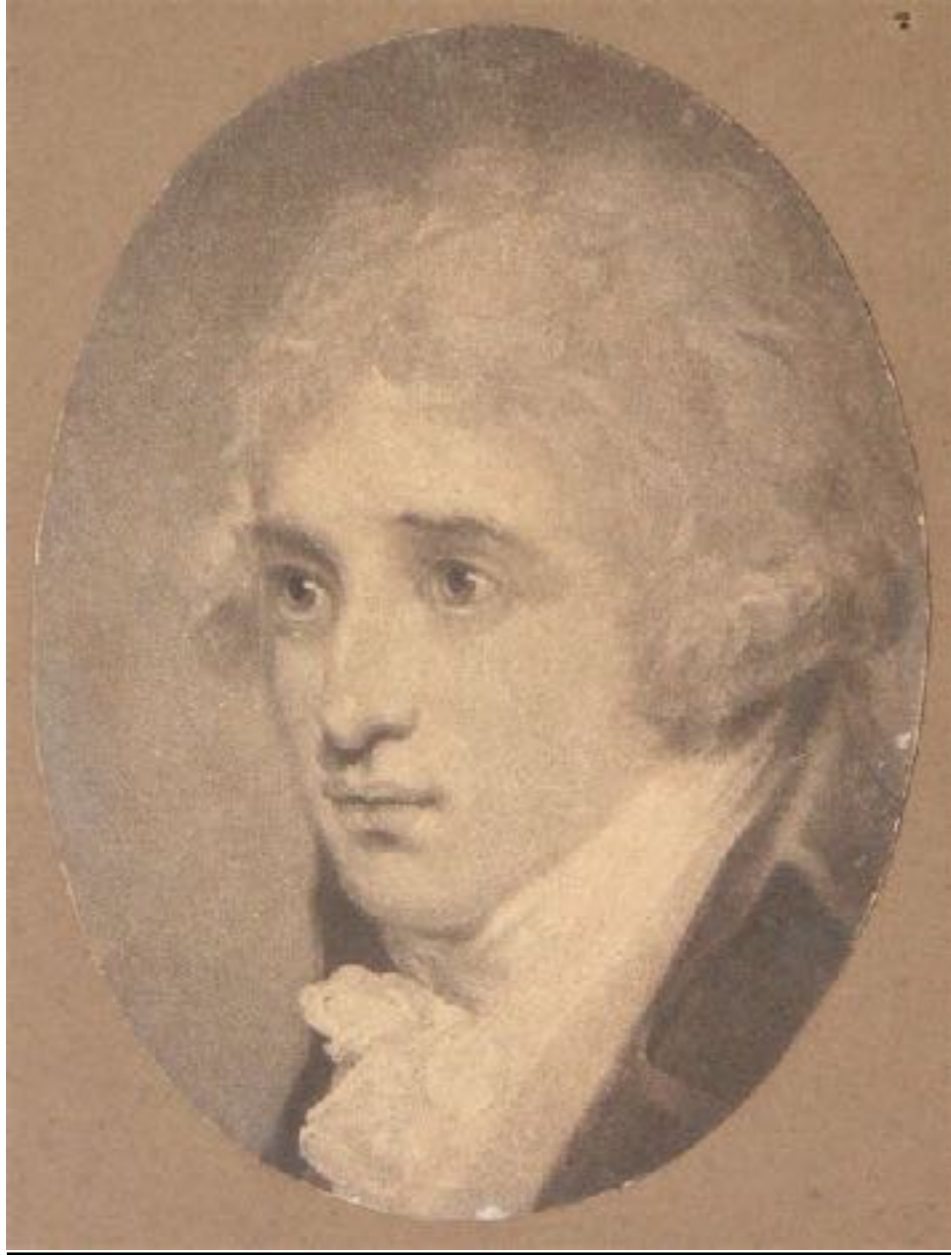

Glen Allen My Community, Part 6:

The Greenhow Johnston home was possibly built about the same time as the one at Meadow Farm. All of these farms were at one time owned by descendants of William Sheppard, who according to tradition, came over in his own ship. The Johnston home as originally built of logs, but has been remodeled.

Another place of interest was "Ridge Farm" the home of the Courtneys. It is 64' higher than Laurel. The Winston Farm, situated about two miles west of the station was owned by Peter Winston, father of James Winston, Secretary and Treasurer of the R.F. & P.R.R., and grandfather of Nannie

Winston who was quite an authoress. Two of the books she published were "The Grace of Orders" and "Waters That Pass Away".
