Open Meeting-Sunday July 17, after Morning Worship. Calling everyone who would like to participate in the annual Shoebox Ministry for Samaritan's Purse. We will begin collecting in early September to pack Shoeboxes to be shipped in November. With the dire economic situations some American families will face this Christmas, turmoil on many continents, and the refugee situation in Europe, the need is great and we need to begin now to have a successful campaign. We'll meet for a few minutes in the Sanctuary to discuss this opportunity.

What you can do now:

- 1. Pray for success of this effort. Pray for those families and children who will be receiving our love gifts. To date, Samaritan's Purse has distributed nearly 7,000 metric tons of food in Ukraine. They have shipped 20 missions of relief into Ukraine itself and are a part of ministry to 7 million refugees from Ukraine who are spread across Europe. Samaritan's Purse has a partner network of 3,000 churches in Ukraine and neighboring Moldova. You can be sure that your gifts will get to a needy child and his/her family this Christmas!
- 2. There will be a weekly Scripture focus starting soon. Look for it.
- 3. Shopping--When you see a good buy, pick up an item or two. Many people shop during the tax free weekends for school supplies for this ministry.
- 4. If you would rather make a monetary donation, designate it on your check or offering envelope. Each box we send will need \$10 in shipping costs sent with it.
