I hope you will prioritize this time of worship on Sundays. Our Lenten rhythm is specifically designed to help us reflect, repent, and remember. We will repeat a couple of hymns and a prayer of confession each week to prepare ourselves for Easter.

Easter is so much richer when we walk to the empty tomb with care and intentionality. We will understand Jesus' love and sacrifice at deeper levels and proclaim with great joy, "Christ the Lord is risen! He is risen, indeed!"
